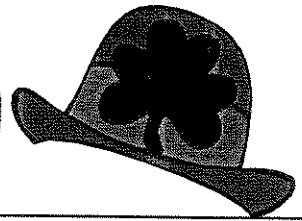

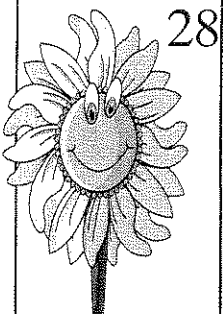

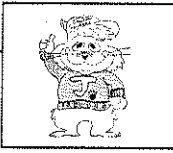

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Getting your child to school on a daily basis on time is one of the most important things you can do for his/her education. Students who are not in school miss out on extremely valuable learning opportunities. Another reason attendance is so important is that schools are funded based on the number of days their students are present. During these lean budget times, this becomes even more important. We receive around \$28 for each day your child is at school. This means the better our attendance, the more state money we receive, which in turn increases the number of programs we can offer. We lose money every day your child is not at school. Therefore, it is extremely important to get your child to school on a daily basis, and schedule appointments around school hours whenever possible.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Jackson Elementary School will be holding Kindergarten registration for the 10-11 School Year on **March 11 from 2:30-5:00PM.** *You will need to bring a copy of your child's immunization records, official birth certificate (not hospital copy) and proof of residence (PG&E bill, etc) in order to complete the enrollment process.* There will be a dentist providing **FREE "Oral Health Assessments"** during registration. Please bring your child with you to registration if you'd like to take advantage of this service that will help families meet one of the requirements for kindergarten. There is also a 'healthy-child' physical that is required for school. Please discuss this with your doctor when taking your child for their kindergarten booster shots. Registration Packets may be picked up in advance, after February 23rd.
