7.1 **Resolution 2017/2018-12 Calling for Full and Fair Funding of California's Public Schools – Discussion/Action (Dr. Slavensky)**
Currently, California ranks 41st in per-pupil funding, 45th in the percentage of revenue devoted to public schools, and last or nearly last in almost every measure of school staffing, such as student-teacher ratio or the number of counselors, students, librarians or nurses per student. Recent efforts to address the funding issue, like the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), simply restored funding to the pre-recession levels of 2007, doing little to close the funding gap between California and other states. In order to better serve students, rectify years of underinvestment in California public schools and build a brighter future for this state, Superintendent Slavensky recommends the Board approve this resolution for Full and Fair Funding of California public schools. Board Clerk Thompson moved to approve item 7.1 and Board member Oneto seconded the motion. **The motion passed 5-0 with 1 advisory vote in favor of the motion.**
