- Approval to run program from June 10th, 2019 through August 9th, 2019.
- Location: Increased to 6 locations this year including, Jackson Elementary, Jackson Park, Pioneer Elementary, Amador High, Plymouth Elementary, Ione Junior.
- Eligibility: Anyone under the age of 18
- Meals: Breakfast & Lunch at Jackson Elementary and Lunch only at all other sites, Monday through Friday
- Served 3769 Breakfasts served & 4947 lunches served in the summer of 2018.
