# ACUSD Prepares for Hybrid Students to Return to Campus 4 Days a Week

**01** Can we accommodate all students currently on hybrid?

Yes. All students currently on the hybrid model will automatically be invited to attend school on campus 4 days a week following the same daily schedule.

**02** What if a student on Distance Learning wants to switch to hybrid now?

Please fill out the survey that was sent on Tuesday, March 9th. We currently have a waiting list for each school but will accommodate as many students as possible.

**03** If we are already in the hybrid model what do we need to do?

Nothing- just plan to attend school in-person 4 days per week starting April 6!



**04** I did not receive the survey on March 9th. What do I do?  
Contact Demi Wright at (209)257-5353 and she will help you! You should also contact your child(s) school and make sure your contact information is up to date.

**05** Why can't every student go back to school 5 days a week?  
We still have to follow the State guidelines for reopening. Not every classroom has the physical capacity to fit every student and maintain the required distance. ACUSD continues to work closely with Amador County Public Health and follow our Health & Safety Plan.

**06** My family has a specific need that we need help working out. Who can help me?  
We understand that no two families have the same needs right now. Reach out to your child(s) school Principal for help. Principals are working with families to make any needed accommodations.



**07** What is the plan for 4 days a week?  
The daily schedule will be the same for instruction. Some lunch schedules may change. Hybrid students will attend every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Each school will send site specific information to families after spring break.

**08** Who can we follow up with if we have additional questions between now and April 6th?
