Special Education Information

Special Education programs and classrooms are located throughout the district. All programs are supported by instructional assistants who help you with the routine and lesson plans.

RSP (Resource Specialist Program) - Teachers work with students, in small groups or individually, throughout the day.

SDC (Special Day Class) - Teachers work with students for the majority of the school day, with students participating in mainstreaming during a portion of the day.

NOTE: Special Day Classes are offered for students with severe disabilities, as well as for students with learning disabilities.
