



Phased School Reopening

- **Stage 1: Distance Learning (DL)**
- For counties in the purple tier, this is the only option to open the school year.
- **Stage 2: Limited Student Access (8/25/2020 CDPH Guidance) ~ Effective 10/19/2020**
 - *DL continues for all students.*
 - *This may happen when a county is in the purple tier and other tiers.*
 - *Special Education students, English learners and students far below grade level will return for assessments, services, and instruction in small groups.*
 - *Information will be communicated to these families.*
- **Stage 3: Hybrid Learning ~ Effective 11/16/2020**
 - *When allowable, pending Amador County Public Health Officer approval.*
 - *Must follow CDPH Guidance for Schools and School-Based Programs such as mandatory mask wearing and 6 foot distancing.*
 - *Details provided in the Learning Continuity Plan.*
- **Stage 3.5: Increased Hybrid In-Person Learning to 4 Days/Week ~ Effective 4/6/2021**
We are here.
- **Stage 4: Traditional Schedule with Restrictions**
 - *Five days a week on campus instruction.*
 - *Daily sanitizing, social distancing, and mask wearing, pending CDPH guidance.*
 - *Limits on large gatherings, extracurricular activities and athletics, pending CDPH guidance.*
- **Stage 5: Traditional Schedule with No Restrictions**
 - *Five days a week on campus instruction.*
 - *Assemblies, extracurricular activities and athletics.*
 - *Daily health screenings may still be required.*
