

How to take a college course while in high school

- Amador County Unified School District high school Juniors & Seniors can take college courses
- These courses will remain on your college transcript for the entirety of your college career.
- These courses are usually completely **FREE** to high school students and can include ACUSD providing the necessary textbooks.
- Your college financial aid 'clock' does not begin while taking college courses while still enrolled in high school.

12 Steps to taking a college course

Step 1 - **Apply to the college**

Step 2 – Look for your student ID number (also called a W number)

Step 3 – Complete and submit the required forms

Step 4 – Complete Orientation and make an appointment with a counselor

Step 5 – **Check your college email/Log into Canvas**

Step 6 – Log in to **ConnectColumbia**

Step 7 – Register for your class(es)

Step 8 – Pay your fees

Tips: High school students can attend Columbia College tuition-free (enrolled in 11 units or less). However, there is a small per-term fee (usually under \$30) that must be paid. Books and supplies for each class are also the responsibility of the student.

Step 9 – **Print or download your schedule**

Step 10 – **Look for and purchase the required textbooks for your class(es)**

Check into which books you will need to purchase. Consult with Nickie Crofts at ACC for more information.

Step 11–**Buy a parking pass if attending an on-campus class**

Step 12 – **Attend class**
